

INTELLIGENCE ALERT

VEHICLE FRAUD: ARIZONA BLANK VEHICLE TITLES TAKEN IN ROBBERY

On 11/06/2009 at approx 1110hrs, suspect/s entered the Arizona License & Title Services office located at 9005 N 29TH AVE; Phoenix at gunpoint forcing an employee and customers to the ground, demanding all titles. They were given titles from the safe and printer, and stole 1,357 blank Arizona certificates of title as well as approximately \$1,300 cash. (Phoenix PD Report No: 2009-91766143).



S01: Hispanic Male, 20-25yrs, 5-08/160, short dark hair, clean shaven, large mole on cheek near nose, chrome semi-auto pistol

S02: Hispanic Male, 20-25yrs, 5-00/150, chrome revolver

SV: WHT 2005-09 FORD P/U ext 4-dr quad cab, FXT model, dark tinted windows, small metal 5th wheel rear gate

- Arizona Certificate of Title is computer printed on 8 x 10 inch, security-featured paper.
- Control Number is printed in red ink in upper right corner of document.
- Stolen Certificate of Title cannot be queried NCIC by the control number.
- Certificate now bears an 8-digit Control Number instead of re-using 7-digit numbers.

The Arizona Certificates of Title listed above, may not be used as proof of ownership, are fraudulent if presented for any purpose and constitute possession of stolen property. The ADOT/OIG will assist in prosecution of any criminal charges filed in connection with these stolen blank title forms.
